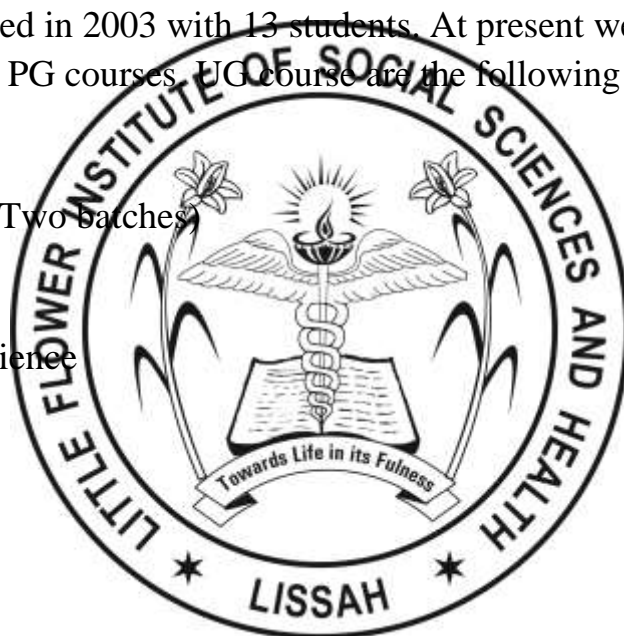
The college established in 2003 with 13 students. At present we have 625 students. We have 6 UG and 5 PG courses. UG course are the following

NSS

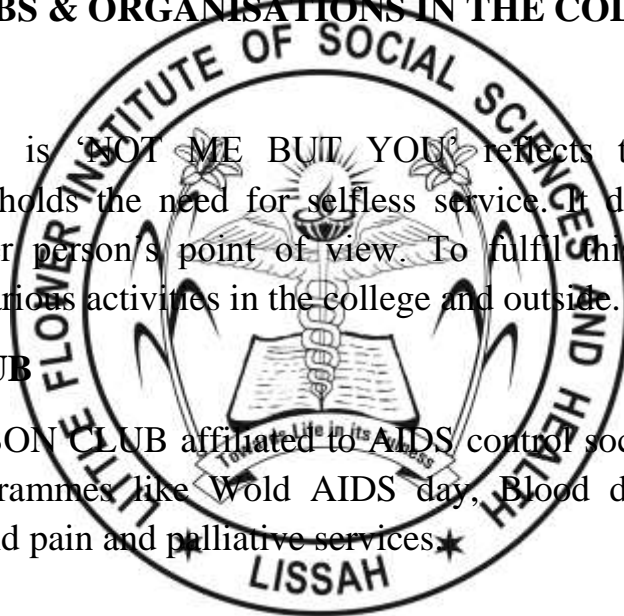

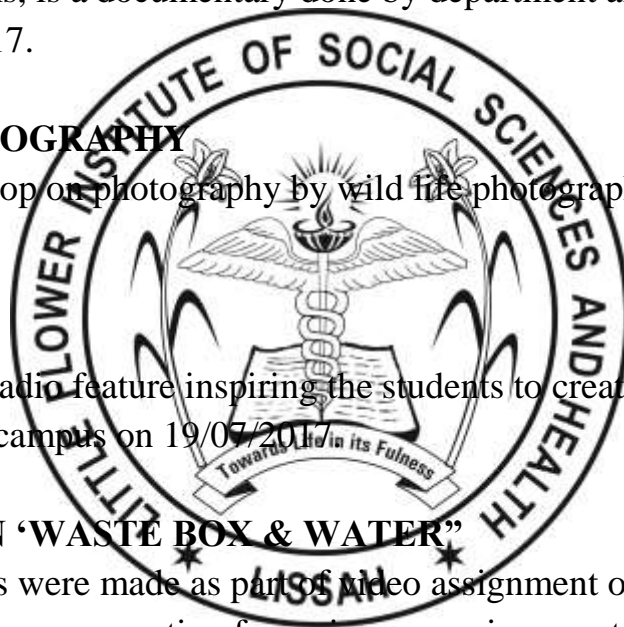
These two short films were made as part of video assignment on the theme of waste management and water preservation focussing on environment.

NSS volunteers participated in this programme and inaugurated by the Deputy Major, Meera Darshak on 02/11/2017.

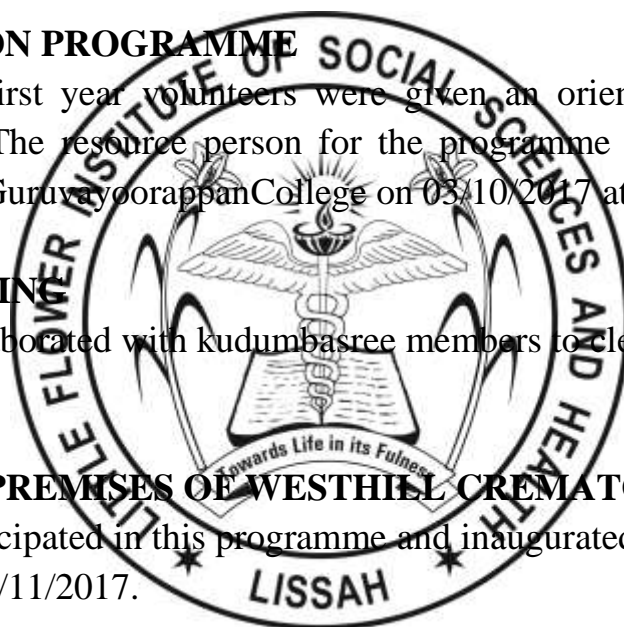
6. DRUG AWARENESS CLASS

11.AVARAM- INTERCOLLEGE NSS FEST

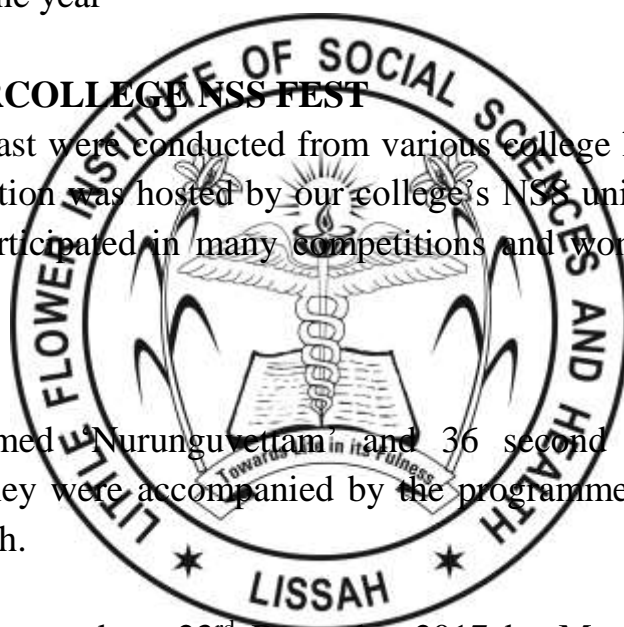

The camp was wound up with a valedictory function on 29.12.2017. The presidential address was given by Mrs. Sujatha Amarambalam (Panchayath president).

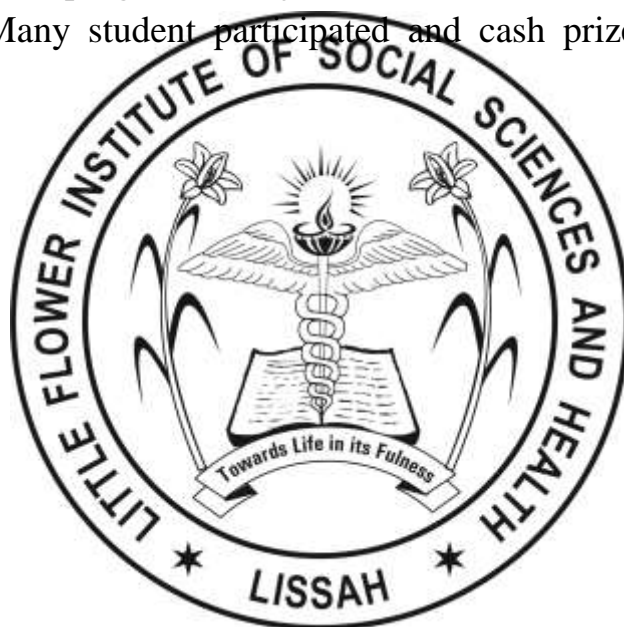


NJATTUVELA
