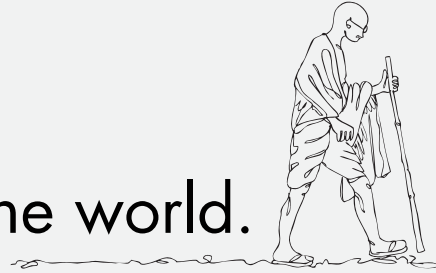

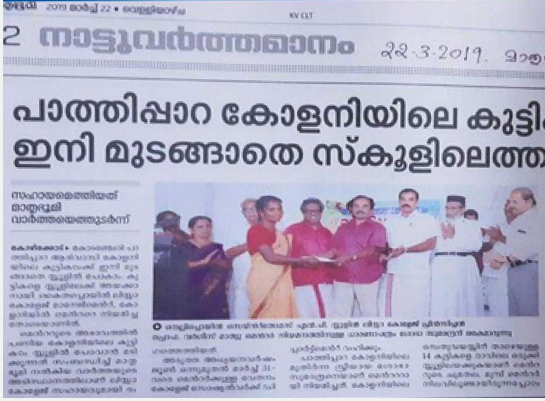
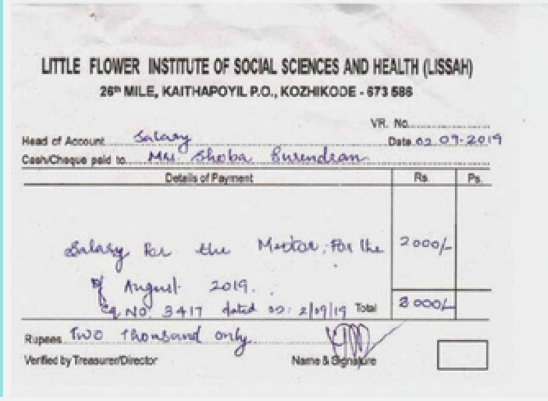


Tribal Colony Adoption and Community Engagement Programme

Community Living Camp

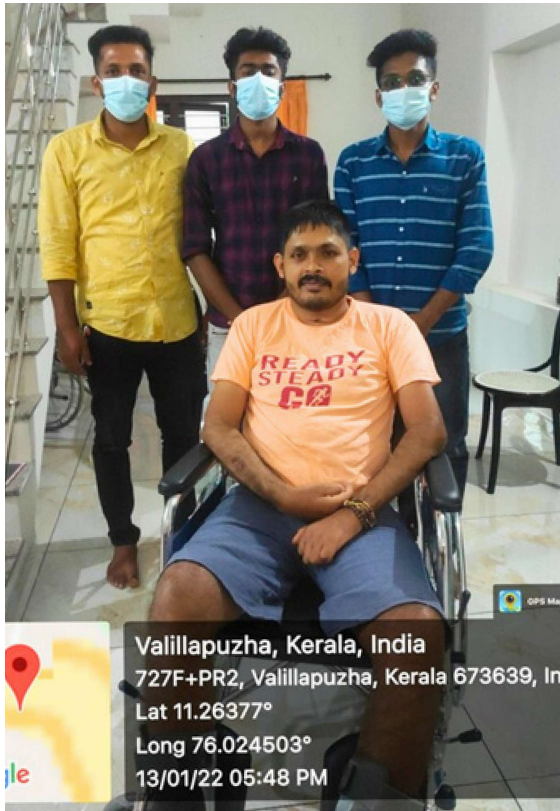

Free Medical Camp

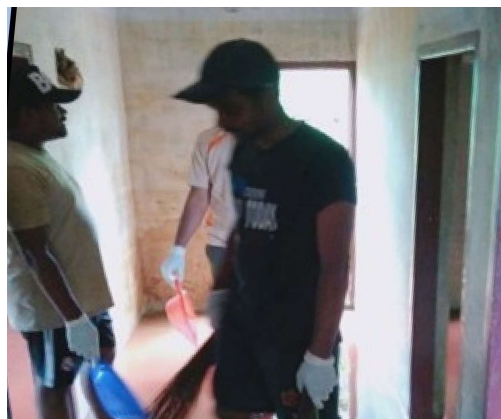
